When the final forfeiture of the Lords of the Isles took place at the end of the 15th century, the MacLeod's got charters of their island estates from the Crown Leod, the progenitor of this Clan was one of three sons of Olave the Black, King of Man and the Isles He was born early in the 13th century He died 1237
